White

Slovenia – Goriska Brda 36

Chardonnay/Rubula, Gasper 2017

Light straw colour, this is a fresh and fruity wine that displays hints of peach and citrus.

Australia – Margaret River 38

Sauvignon Blanc/Semillon, Domaine Naturaliste 2016

Bold aromas of red currant, passion fruit and orange blossom laced with exotic notes of lychee and clove. A creamy mouth filling palate delights the senses with an unexpected richness and depth of flavor.

Red Wine

Italy - Puglia 36

Primitivo, La Masseria 2017

Deep ruby red in colour, with aromas of confected red fruits, blueberries and sweet spices on the nose. It is full bodied, well balanced with soft tannins and a spicy finish.

Spain – Ribera Del Duero 39

Tempranillo, Marques de Burgos 2016

Brilliant Crimson, flavours of ripe wild red fruits combined with notes of liquorice, coffee and vanilla. Fleshy, with long velvety finish.

White Wine

South Africa – Coastal Region 45

Viognier, Fairview 2015

Powerful stone fruit and honeysuckle aromas, followed by a full bodied palate with spice and lingering fruit flavours.

Germany - Pfalz 35

Riesling, Lingenfelder Bird Label 2016

This crisp, refreshing Riesling is at first wonderfully floral on the nose and finishes with peachy fruit on the palate.

France – Burgundy 69

Chardonnay, Chablis 1er Cru, Domaine Corinne Perchaud 2014

The initial bouquet is floral, followed by citrus aromas such as orange and fresh pear notes. The palate is mineral with a citrus vein. It is a full-bodied and well-balanced wine.

New Zealand – Marlborough 39

Sauvignon Blanc, Stopbanks 2017

Intense aromas of passion fruit, complemented by ripe gooseberry, herbal notes and a touch of lime. It is a light-bodied, dry, crisp wine with lime and herbal tones on the palate

Austria – Kamptal 42

Grüner Veltliner ‘Lois’, Loimer 2017

Pale lemon in the glass. Fresh green apple and spicy notes. Full bodied and juicy, supported by harmonious acidity and herbal, peppery nuances that mingle with juicy green apple flavours.

France – Loire Valley 39

Chenin Blanc, Vouvray Sec, Chateau Moncontour, 2017

Pale Lemon in colour, and is reminiscent of green apples and white flowers. The palate is crisp, clean and beautifully balanced.

Portugal – Vinho Verde 49

Alvarinho, Morgadio Da Torre 2017

Lemon yellow in appearance with youthful hints of green. Aromas of peach, pineapple and jasmine blossom. The fruit is supported by mineral notes.

New Zealand - Marlborough 42

Pinot Gris, Little Beauty 2014

Sun blush apricot, black jelly bean, nougat. Hints of floral such as jasmine and apple blossom.

Italy - Veneto

Garganega, Soave DOP Classico, Rizzardi 2016 34

Lightly floral with cool fruit and citrus on the nose, leading to a vibrant palate with crisp apple and citrus under laid by a stony, mineral quality

Spain – Galicia 39

Albarino, Burgans 2017

Ripe with citrus and tangerine notes on the nose, with a ripe tropical hint. Joined by floral aromas with hawthorn, jasmine and orange blossom, and a herbal hay character.

Red Wine

- USA – California** 42
Cabernet Sauvignon, Fog Mountain 2017
Deep garnet colour with aromas of dark red fruits on the nose. Rich flavors of dried plums, Medjool dates, red currants and bright berries flavors on the palate. The wine has soft, round tannins and a lingering finish.
- Argentina – Mendoza** 38
Malbec Clasico, Altos Las Hormigas 2016
This Malbec is deep violet-red in colour. The nose displays characteristic notes of red fruits, raspberries and plums with white pepper.
- Chile – Maipo Valley** 46
Syrah Gran Reserva Origen, Vina Chocolan 2015
Floral perfumed aromas complimenting the ever present bramble fruit and liquorice.
- France – Bordeaux** 55
Merlot/Cabernet Sauvignon, St. Geroges St. Emilion, Clos Saint Jacques 2015
A rich wine with Merlot as the majority of the blend with plenty of spiced plum and soft tannins from St. Emilion.
- Portugal - Douro** 39
Touriga Franca/Tinto Roriz/Tinta Barroca, Altano DOC Organic 2017
A beautifully balanced, very pure, organic red bursting with the dark berry fruit we expect from Douro Valley.
- Australia – Adelaide Hills** 38
Shiraz, Hen’s Teeth 2015
This Shiraz is a model of cool restrained fruit, balance and complexity, lush ripe fruit.
- New Zealand - Marlborough** 39
Pinot Noir, Tinpot Hut 2016
Intense aromatics of black cherry and plum mingle with subtle toasty oak. The dark stone fruits are complemented by subtle cassis and hints of bramble, with a well balanced acidity.
- France – Beaujolais** 35
Gamay, Dominique Morel 2017
Clear ruby in the glass with delicate cherry perfumes. The rounded palate is full of fresh red berry fruit. Elegant, well balanced with good acidity.
- Italy – Veneto** 44
Corvina/Corvinone/Rondinella, Valpolicella Ripasso, Rizzardi 2013
The distinct black pepper and dark cherry of Corvina greet the nose. No oak here, just a mix of wild dark berry fruit and a complex truffle undertone. Medium bodied with perfectly balanced acidity.
- Spain – Rioja** 39
Tempranillo, Rioja Crianza Bodegas LAN 2015
Intense red cherry colour. Aromas of red fruits - strawberry, raspberry and cranberry with hints of vanilla and toffee. Silky and structured on the palate, a long-lasting and satisfying finish.
